# Kenya | November 2020

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## 1 November | Depart South Africa – Nairobi | (1 night) D

Depart South Africa for our direct flight to Nairobi.

On arrival, we will be met and transferred to our hotel for dinner & overnight.

Overnight at the **Wildebeest Eco Camp**

*(The Camp is conveniently located in the beautiful Karen/Langata suburb of Nairobi. It has green, lush gardens & a lovely swimming pool.)*

## 2 November | Nairobi - Amboseli National Park| (2 nights) BLD

In the morning, we will receive a short briefing before the adventure begins with the drive to **Amboseli National Park**.

We will arrive at the lodge in time for lunch, before heading out for the afternoon game drive.

Overnight at **OI Tukai Lodge**

*(The Lodge is one of the best spots in the world to watch elephants with the backdrop of Africa's highest mountain, Mount Kilimanjaro.)*

## 3 November | Amboseli National Park| B L D

The day is ours to relax and enjoy what the Park has to offer. We will have morning and afternoon game drives.

Crowned by Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak, the Amboseli National Park is one of Kenya's most popular parks. The name "Amboseli" comes from a Maasai word meaning "**salty dust**", and it is one of the best places in Africa to view **large herds of elephants** up close. Nature lovers can explore five different habitats here ranging from the dried-up bed of Lake Amboseli, wetlands with sulphur springs, to the savannah and woodlands.

Overnight at our lodge.

## 4 November | Amboseli National Park – OI Pejeta Conservancy | (2 nights) BLD

After breakfast, we will make our way to our next exciting destination for the next two days, the **OI Pejeta Conservancy**.

Resting at the foothills of **Mount Kenya and the Aberdare Mountain Range**, in Central Kenya's Laikipia County, the OI Pejeta Conservancy is the **largest black rhino sanctuary** in East Africa. Originally a working cattle ranch in colonial Kenya and now a pioneering wildlife conservancy, OI Pejeta works to protect wildlife and provide a **sanctuary for rescued chimpanzees**.



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The Conservancy is a popular safari destination and is home to the 'Big Five', as well as a wide selection of other African animals including: zebra, giraffe, hippo, cheetah, jackal, serval, hyena & vervet monkey.

Overnight at **Sweetwaters Serena Camp**

*(The Tented Camp offers a charming blend of under-canvas ambiance and safari luxury, each with their own private veranda overlooking the waterhole.)*

## 5 November | Ol Pajeta Conservancy | BLD

Today we will head back to the Ol Pajeta Conservancy to explore some more. You are also welcome to take part in a range of optional activities offered by the lodge such as Lion Tracking, Guided Bush Walk (and/or Ravine River Bird Walk) .

Overnight at our Lodge.

## 6 November | Ol Pajeta Conservancy – Lake Nakuru National Park | (1 night) BLD

After breakfast we will make our way to Lake Nakuru where we will have a picnic lunch, whereafter we will head out for our afternoon game drive.

Located in the **Great Rift Valley**, surrounded by yellow acacia woodlands and bushy shrublands, the **Lake Nakuru National Park** was created to protect the Lake and its large flocks of **Lesser Flamingo**, which are drawn to the algae which flourishes in the saline waters of this soda lake. The national park is inhabited by some 50+ mammal species. It is also known as a bird watcher's paradise, home to over **450 bird species**. Visitors can look forward to hiking through the scenic landscape, picnicking next to this magnificent lake, and spotting an array of wildlife whilst on a game drive.

Overnight at **Mbweha Camp**

*(Nestled on the southern border of Lake Nakuru National Park, Mbweha Camp is a small lodge that consists of charming rustic cottages.)*



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## 7 November | Lake Nakuru – Maasai Mara | (2 nights) BLD

After breakfast we will make our way to our last safari destination of the trip, the famous **Maasai Mara National Park**. The vast open grasslands of the Maasai Mara are well-known throughout the world, as the host of the **annual migration**, when **1.3 million wildebeest** and **zebra** cross from the Serengeti to the Maasai Mara, in search of greener pastures.

Given high densities of both resident and transient populations of game, including lion, cheetah, leopard, elephant, rhino, giraffe, hyena and over 450 species of birds, the Maasai Mara provides unrivalled game viewing throughout the year.

The **1510 square kilometres Maasai Mara National Reserve which borders Tanzania's Serengeti National Park is surrounded by approximately 12 conservation areas**. These conservancies have been established as partnerships between the private sector and local Maasai landowners, to ensure the conservation of the Great Mara-Serengeti ecosystem and the protection of its wildlife.

Overnight at **Basecamp Masai Mara**

*(Basecamp Masai Mara offers luxurious Riverside Tents built along the banks of the Talek River, the natural border to the Masai Mara National Reserve. The dense riverbed foliage allows for privacy and comfort, without compromising the view of the Masai Mara National Reserve just a stone throw away.)*

## 8 November | Maasai Mara | BLD

Today we will have plenty of time for more extensive game drives through the beautiful Maasai Mara, including a stop at the **Mara River**.

Overnight at our Camp

## 9 November | Maasai Mara – Diani Beach | (3 nights) B D

The morning is yours to relax and after an early lunch we will be transferred to the local **airstrip** for our flight to **Diani** where we will spend time on the beach for the next few days.

The palm-fringed picturesque coastline with its exotic coral reefs, secluded islands, sacred forests, unspoilt bays and breath-taking white sandy beaches, provide an idyllic tropical paradise for relaxing at the end of an epic safari !

The East African coast has a shallow shelf stretching out to a coral reef and at low tide the rock pools provide fascinating views of marine life: crabs, shells, eels, starfish, sea urchins and fish nursery pools, while at high tide, the warm sheltered waters are ideal for swimming and snorkelling.



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## Overnight at **Pinewood Beach Resort and Spa**

*(Situated on the unspoiled shores of the wonderfully warm Indian Ocean, this small and stylish beach resort offers wonderful relaxation on the beach).*

## **10 & 11 November | Diani Beach | B D**

The days are yours to relax on the beach & swim in the warm Indian Ocean.

## **12 November | Diani Beach - Nairobi | B D**

After breakfast we take the short flight to Nairobi.

We will enjoy an afternoon of touring, visiting first the David Sheldrick **Elephant Orphanage**, having the opportunity of seeing the orphaned elephant babies and their guardians, a truly memorable experience. We will continue to the **Giraffe Centre** and the **Karen Blixen Museum**, the former home of the famous Danish author known for her book, *Out of Africa*.

We will end our tour at **Corinne & George Corvin's home (Michael's sister)** where we will be **hosted for drinks & dinner**.

Transfer to our hotel for overnight at the **Eka Hotel**.

*(A contemporary style hotel conveniently close to the airport for the morning flight home).*




